I. Roll Call Chief Anderson went through the roll call of the committee.

II. Minutes Tina moved to approve the minutes of September 3, 2009 and Jon seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

III. Public Comment There was no public comment.

IV. Update on 2009 Goals Committee members reviewed the 2009 Goals, recorded in a separate document titled, PSAC 2009 Goals and attached to these minutes. Other additional discussion around goals:

V. Problem Solving Districts

Sgt. Wendland explained that these districts would be for purposes of responsibility and accountability by assigned teams, but would not restrict them to call responses in assigned district. Presently, 2 districts are being considered. The focus would be to look at information provided by neighborhood watch and citizens and crime statistics to focus on problems in their district. Creation of the district is tied to crime mapping both in providing data on how to accurately split the districts, but to have the crime analysis in place in order to implement solving crimes. January 2010 could be the target date.

Jason affirmed the value in that when you have officers focused on specific areas, they become acutely aware of the issues and take a high level of ownership in the solutions. Jorgan discussed her experiences as a property manager in Rockwood station, Gresham and how important the cooperative relationship with police was essential (in that case, a police substation in the area).

VI. Closing Comments

There being no further business, Tina moved to adjourn the meeting and John seconded the motion. At the vote, all were in favor and meeting adjourned. The next meeting will be held on Thursday November 5th, 2009.
