**I. Roll Call** Chief Anderson went through the roll call of the committee.

**II. Public Comment** There was no public comment.

**III. Minutes** Jason moved to approve the minutes of October 1, 2009 and Jorgan seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

**IV. Update on 2009 Goals** Committee members reviewed the 2009 Goals, recorded in a separate document titled "PSAC 2009 Goals" attached to these minutes.

**V. Problem Solving Districts**

Chief Anderson reported on the status of this project. The department purposefully held off on the defining the districts in order to hear from Command Central, a vendor providing calls and crime reporting statistics in map form, about existing crime map data. Once complete, this data will provide better data to establish equitable distribution of geographic areas of responsibility among officers. The ultimate goal is to roll out the project January 1 of the New Year but internally the Chief wants to have the project drafted by December 1<sup>st</sup>. The department plans to talk with officers, get their feedback, prepare the officers through training, and Otie the program into the Chief's written expectations so all are aware it will be evaluated and has meaning. He noted that officers are enthusiastic about it and see it as a team building opportunity that allows them more focus.

The Chief reported a total of 16 applicants came in for City committees and 9 of them are for PSAC (applicants include existing members). He believes it is a testament to the good work of the committee and the leadership of Mike as chair that participation interest is so high in the PSAC. The Chief gave a personal thanks to the committee members for their success and good work on the committee.

**VI. Closing Comments**

Mike concurred that the success of the committee is that by communicating together the team functions well in approaching and solving problems. There were no other committee comments. Justin moved to adjourn the meeting and Jorgan seconded the motion. All were in favor and the meeting adjourned. The next meeting will be held on Thursday December 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2009.
