I. Roll Call Mike Goss called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

II. Public Comment None.

III. Minutes Jason moved to approve the minutes of March 4, 2010 and Bob A. seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

IV. Review PSAC 2010 Goals The Committee updated each goal's progress in a separate goals document attached to these minutes. In other discussion, Bill asked if the PD had a Plan B in the event the public through ballot box decides that a future date for the levy would be better. The Chief responded that the question of public support will come forward through a survey, authorized by the City Council which is currently underway. With regard to the economy, the City has learned recently that due to the economy, the rate per thousand for the construction of such a bond is significantly less than in 2008 when the original bond was put forward. Bill asked if the City Council or staff has any other ideas about how to do this outside of the ballot process and the Chief indicated that the Mayor and others are exploring if there any ways to do that.

Mike gave a recap of action items related to the goals:

- Read draft Strategic Plan and bring back comments if any to May 6th meeting.
- Chief will provide summary of survey information to PSAC after it's reviewed by the City Administrator and City Council.
- The Chief and Mike will check with Melody about how PSAC goals are distributed to the Council.
- The Chief will talk with Tori about being PSAC point person on Neighborhood Watch to work with department N.W. contact, Sgt. Joel Wendland.
- The Chief will bring a draft of the Problem Solving Districts to the May meeting.
- Jorgan will prepare a checklist related to the Toy Drive to make sure things run smoothly.

V. Closing Comments Tina indicated she would like to meet with Sgt. Kaer as he is in charge of the awards ceremony as there were a few things she had to add to the debriefing which she missed. She has been on vacation but is ready to get to work again.

The Chief noted the amazing work the group is doing and expressed his appreciation for the group.

Tina moved to adjourn and Bill seconded the motion. All were in favor, the motion passed and the meeting adjourned.
