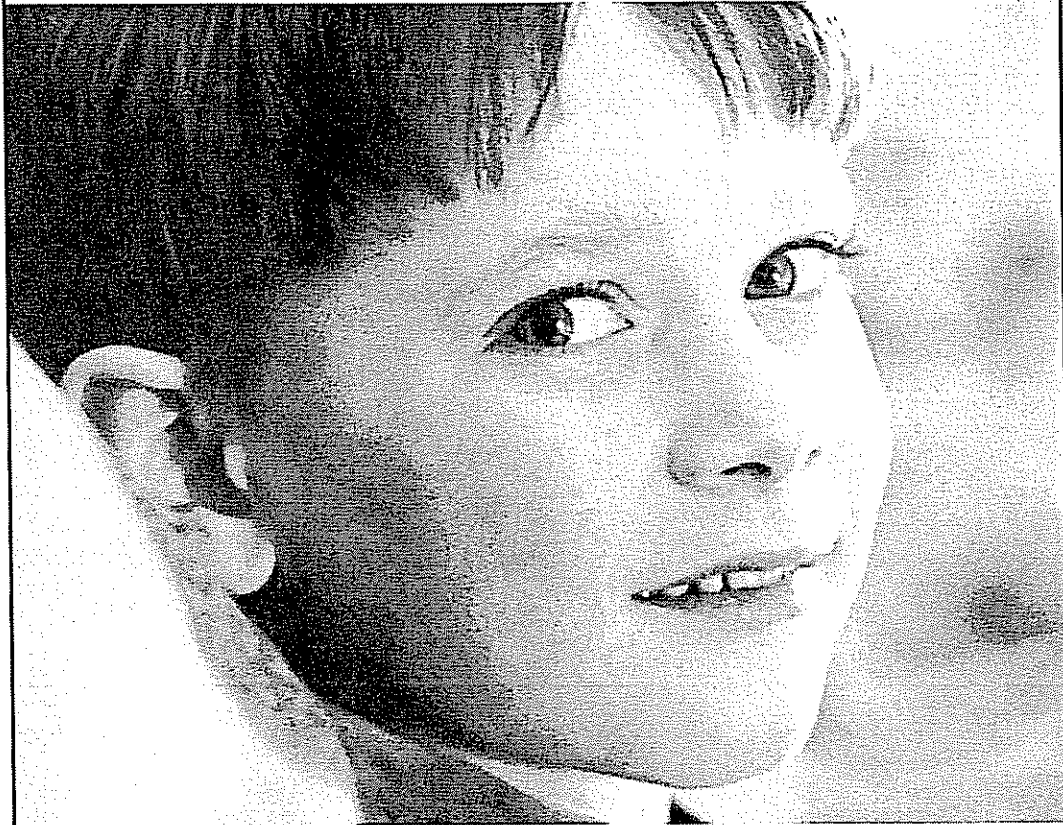


# What's the number one cause of death and injury for Oregon's kids?
