I. Roll Call Mike Goss called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

II. Public Comment None.

III. Minutes Justin moved to approve the minutes of April 1, 2010 and Bob T. seconded the motion. All were in favor and the motion passed.

IV. Review PSAC 2010 Goals The Committee updated each goal's progress in a separate goals document attached to these minutes. In discussion, the 3 Neighborhood Watch goals were combined into one goal with subsets. Two agenda items for May were requested:

- 1) Have DJ with McMenam's come in and talk about at the next award ceremony (what their sponsorship entailed) and
- 2) Discuss draft strategic plan circulated by the Chief.
- 3) Have the Chief update the group on what is going on with crime analysis.

V. Police Facility Survey Results The group discussed the results of the police facility which was distributed along with a staff report which will be presented to the City Council Tuesday May 11th. Chair Goss adjourned the meeting for a brief recess and the meeting reconvened at 7:36 p.m.

VI. Closing Comments Tori mentioned a candlelight vigil in honor of fallen police officers during police week on April 17th. Jerry noted that some citizens and churches stepped forward to assist some stranded travelers. Justin noted that a citizen of the year award might be appropriate for these individuals. Jerry noted that at this time of the year, nuisance problems were emerging and given code enforcement went part time (and Jack Hanna recently retired), Mike suggested he bring this up with the Chief to find out how problems were being addressed.

Justin moved to adjourn the meeting and Bill seconded the motion. All were in favor, the motion passed and the meeting adjourned at 7:43 p.m.

If they don't approve some of the department's elements of plan, department wouldn't be working on these items and their goals could affect other budgetary items as well.</p> <p>3/4/10 Due to other deadlines and project priorities, a new due date was assigned.</p> <p>4/1/10 A draft was distributed for the committee to review. A further discussion will take place in May.</p>

<p>1/7/10 Mike explained the background of the committee's goals and how they are updated and reported to the City Council.</p> <p>2/4/10 Melody provided the January 2010 goals document to the Mayor/City Council with the Chief's 1st quarter 2010 report. Future updates will accompany future 2010 quarterly Chief's reports.</p> <p>4/1/10 This occurs every quarter automatically, generated by Police department staff.</p>

<p>1/7/10 Jorgan explained this as a new goal, more discussions about how to develop the plan.</p> <p>2/4/10 Chief and Jorgan attended the "Community Livability Group" (outcome of PAL's GAAP subcommittee). The intention was to see if contacts there might play into future Troutdale neighborhood watch groups. Bob A. did research regarding metro area neighborhood watches and noted that the impetus for the interest is driven by the citizens desire to create it. Bob T. also did research and agreed it tends to ebb and flow around citizen interest. Committee agreed they should network so they don't duplicate interests.</p> <p>3/4/10 Work on the award ceremony goal precluded work on this goal. The Chief suggested this group could meet with him between now and the next PSAC meeting as he has info relevant to the goal.</p> <p>4/1/10 Bob reported a meeting was held and consensus was that staff person or volunteer is needed; that interest be generated by the neighbors or people; and that implementation would be incremental. Timeline is tentatively July 1.</p>

<p>1/7/10 Suggestions to continue to participate with Wood Village's large scale event, continue with local neighborhood block parties, generate more interest by sending out info to neighborhoods to join in the events in Troutdale.</p> <p>2/4/10 Public comment and presentation by speaker is a part of the NNO this year and the date was changed to reflect Wood Village's actual NNO event. Jason notified the City's staff person that volunteers from RSD & Jorgan's group are much appreciated and anticipated. MCSO puts it on with partnerships by SWAT, VCT, Gang teams which gives a uniformed presence from all 3 agencies. Portland, Gresham Fire, AMR and the Coast Guard also attend.</p> <p>3/4/10 Nothing substantive to report but beginning next month's meetings will become more frequent, solicitation of donations will start. Participation by volunteers such as RHS, Jorgan and committee will then be factored into the plan and is very welcome. Jason suggested Troutdale have its own booth or table to announce its presence and their part of supporting Troutdale PD. The more Troutdale officers there the better, activities at the table or give aways, and information are important.</p> <p>4/1/10 PSAC will have a booth for the event which needs to be staffed. Tables, Chair, 10x10 gazebo tent, whatever else that's needed for the event (both Mike and Jason have a tent). He has talked with the Mayor of Wood Village to approach it as more of an East County regional event. 5/6/10 Bill Flynn said that McMenemy's would agree to do the event 100% and DJ should be invited to the June 3 meeting to make sure all parties are on the same page. A checklist was produced by the department for future use. The committee no longer has the fundraising responsibility for the event but could continue with fundraising to augment it.
