

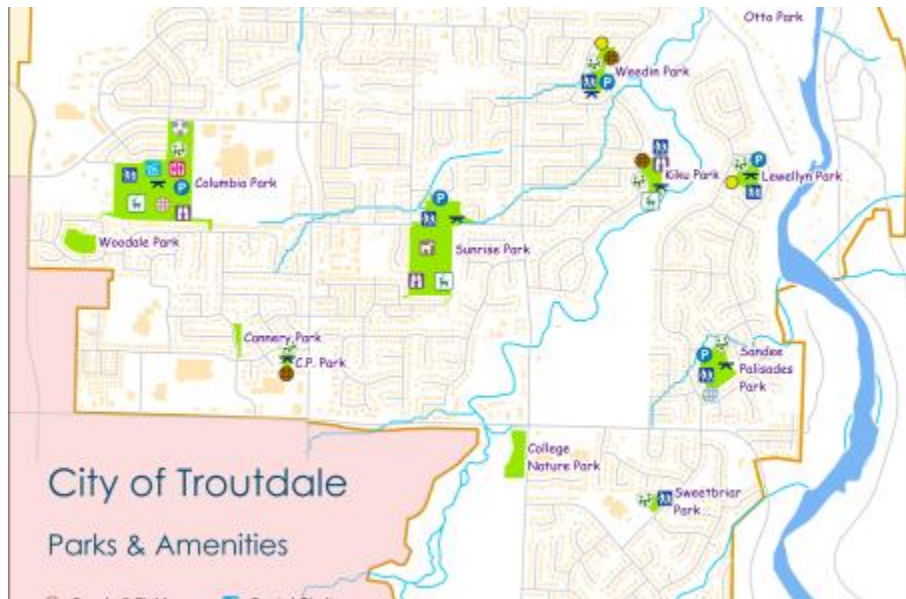
Parks and Greenways
