The Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) is primarily charged with encouraging citizen involvement as identified by Goal 1 of the **Comprehensive Land Use Plan**. The group also works on complex topics on referral by the City Council to provide recommended actions to take or policies to adopt.

The CAC is an 11-member body, appointed by City Council, on staggered, three-year terms.

- **Meeting Dates/Times:** Regular meetings start at 7:00 p.m. on the first Wednesday of a given month
- **Meeting Location:** Troutdale Police Community Center Kellogg Room (234 SW Kendall Ct). We also meet by Zoom.
